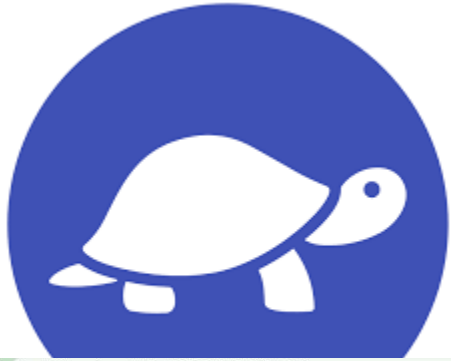

**International Banana Museum – California**
